This section assesses logical reasoning and problem-solving skills.

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2. General Knowledge & General Awareness

This section tests the candidate's awareness of current affairs and general knowledge about India and the world.

Key Topics:

- Indian History and Freedom Struggle
 - Geography (Physical, Economic, and Social)
 - Indian Polity and Constitution
 - Economy and Financial Awareness
 - Science and Technology
 - Environmental Issues
 - Sports and Awards
 - Current Affairs (National & International)
 - Important Dates and Events
 - Culture and Arts
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3. Elementary Mathematics

This section evaluates basic mathematical abilities and numerical aptitude.

Key Topics:

- Number Systems
 - Computation of Whole Numbers, Decimals, and Fractions
 - Ratio and Proportion
 - Percentages
 - Averages
 - Simple and Compound Interest
 - Profit and Loss
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- Time, Speed, and Distance
- Time and Work
- Mensuration (Area and Volume)
- Geometry (Basic concepts)
- Trigonometry (Basic concepts)
- Statistical Charts (Bar Graph, Pie Chart, etc.)

4. English/Hindi Language

This section assesses language proficiency and comprehension in either English or Hindi (candidate's choice).

For English:

- Vocabulary (Synonyms, Antonyms, Word Substitution)
- Grammar (Tenses, Sentence Correction, Active/Passive Voice)
- Comprehension Passages
- Cloze Test
- Spotting Errors
- Sentence Rearrangement

For Hindi:

- Vocabulary (पर्यायवाची, विलोम)
- व्याकरण (समास, सन्धि, वचन, काल, लिंग)
- गद्यांश (Comprehension Passages)
- वाक्य सुधारना
- मुहावरे और लोकोक्तियाँ
