# 1. SSC Stenographer Paper 1 Syllabus (Computer-Based Test)

- Grade C (Stenographer):

  - o Transcription Time:
    - **English**: 40 minutes.
    - **Hindi**: 55 minutes.
- Grade D (Stenographer):

  - **Time**: The dictation will last for 10 minutes.
