1. SSC Stenographer Paper 1 Syllabus (Computer-Based Test)

General Intelligence and Reasoning

- **Analogies:** Verbal and non-verbal analogies, letter and number analogies.
- **Coding-Decoding:** Letter and number codes, number series.
- **Blood Relations:** Family tree, relationships.
- **Direction Sense:** Directional distance problems, clockwise and anti-clockwise.

2. SSC Stenographer Paper 2 Syllabus (Skill Test)

The **Skill Test** is the stenography test, where candidates are required to transcribe the dictated passage into text.

- **Grade C (Stenographer):**
 - **Speed:** 100 words per minute (wpm) in English or 80 wpm in Hindi.
 - **Time:** The dictation will last for 10 minutes.
 - **Transcription Time:**
 - **English:** 40 minutes.
 - **Hindi:** 55 minutes.
 - **Grade D (Stenographer):**
 - **Speed:** 80 wpm in English or 50 wpm in Hindi.
 - **Time:** The dictation will last for 10 minutes.
 - **Transcription Time:**
 - **English:** 50 minutes.
 - **Hindi:** 65 minutes.
